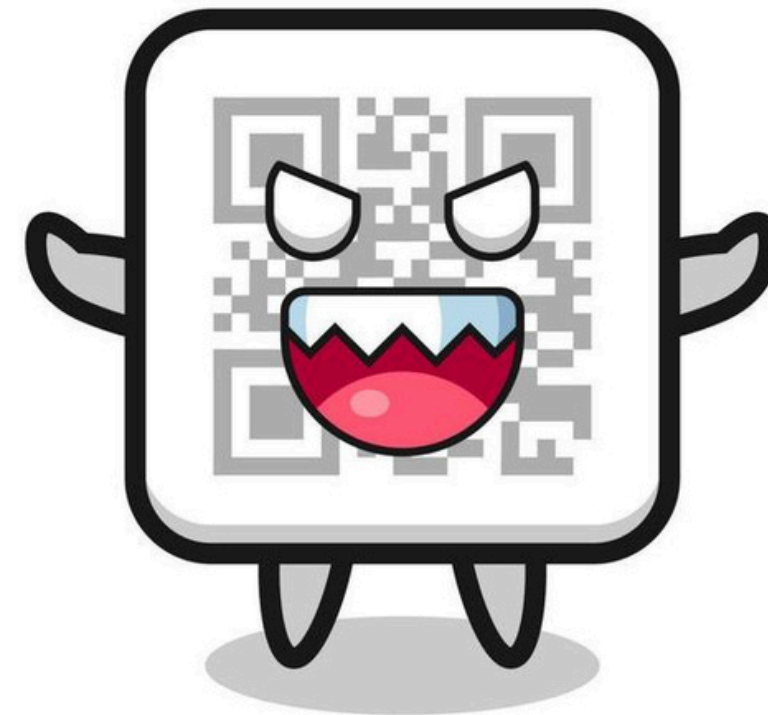

What is Quishing?

A phishing attack where hackers use QR codes to trick victims into opening malicious links

Why it works:

- QR codes hide the actual URL
- People trust QR codes in public places & emails
- Traditional email security tools don't scan QR codes

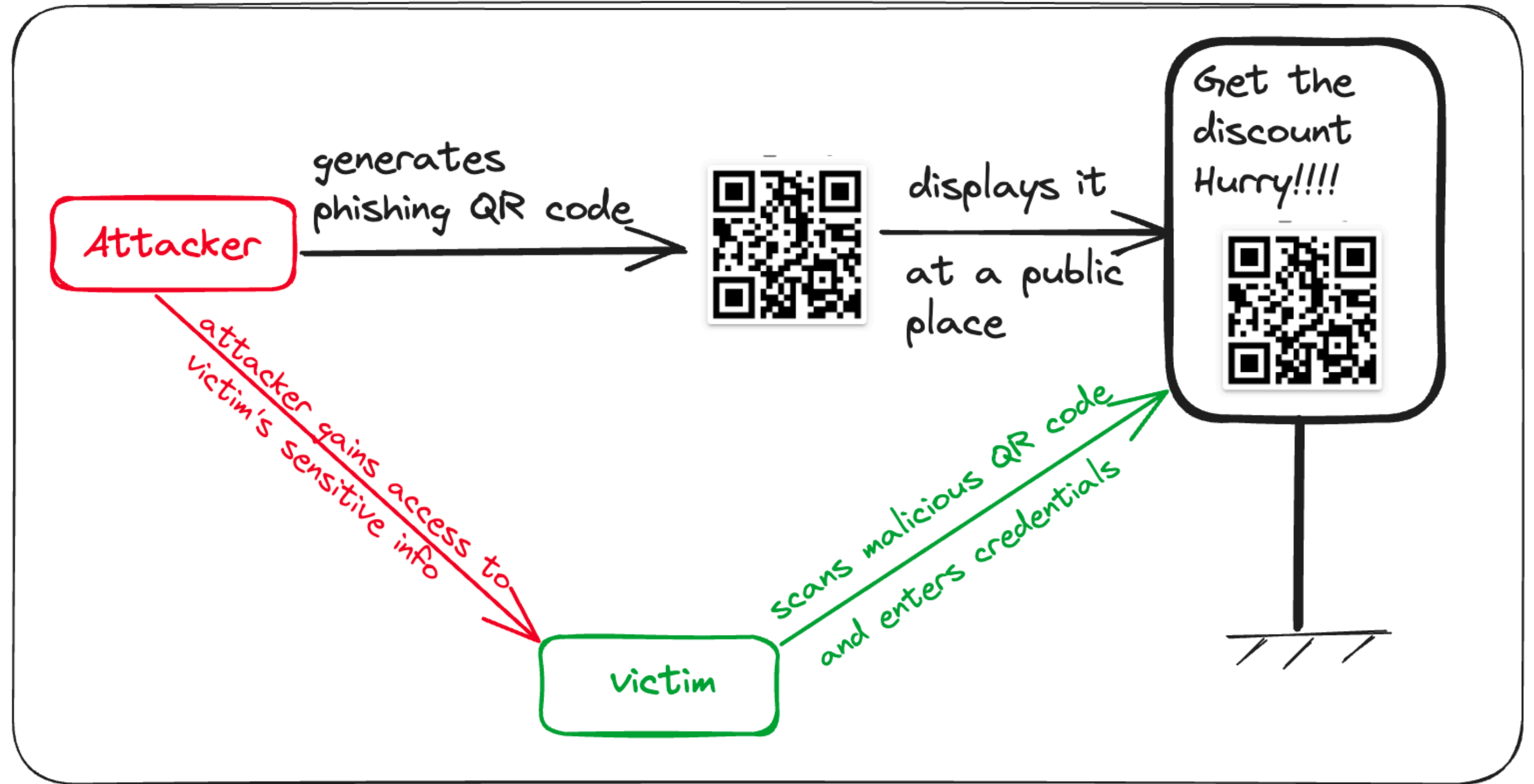


How it Works



- Fake Emails – Attackers send QR codes in emails, pretending to be IT support, banks, or vendors
- Public Posters/Flyers – Malicious QR codes placed in public (e.g., parking meters, event flyers)
- Fake Login Pages – QR codes lead to credential-harvesting sites
- Payment Scams – Attackers replace real payment QR codes with fake ones

Case

Microsoft Warns of Tax-Themed Email Attacks Using PDFs and QR Codes to Deliver Malware

- Microsoft warns of phishing emails using QR codes and tax themes to trick users into visiting fake Microsoft 365 login pages.
- Over 2,300 U.S. organizations were targeted, especially in IT, engineering, and consulting sectors.
- QR codes link to malware and credential theft, with attackers using trusted services to bypass security filters.

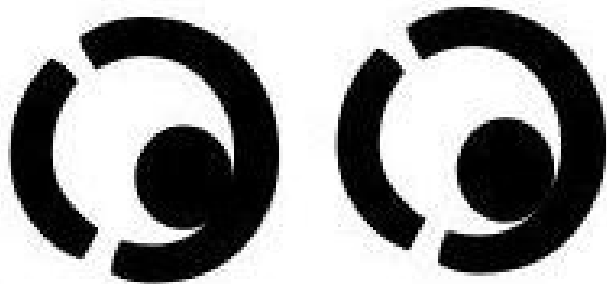


How to Prevent it

- ✓ Verify URLs before scanning – Hover over the QR code (some phone cameras show URLs)
 - ✓ Use Secure QR Scanners – Apps that scan and display URLs before opening
 - ✓ Be Wary of Unsolicited QR Codes – Avoid scanning random codes in emails or public places
 - ✓ Don't Enter Credentials – If a QR code leads to a login page, go to the website manually
 - ✓ Check for QR Code Tampering – Ensure stickers or overlays aren't placed over real QR codes

- **ScanQR.org**: Secure QR Code Scanner.
- **LookyLoo**: A tool for analyzing the behavior of URLs (scan QR codes before visiting links)
- **VirusTotal**: Check if a URL is malicious

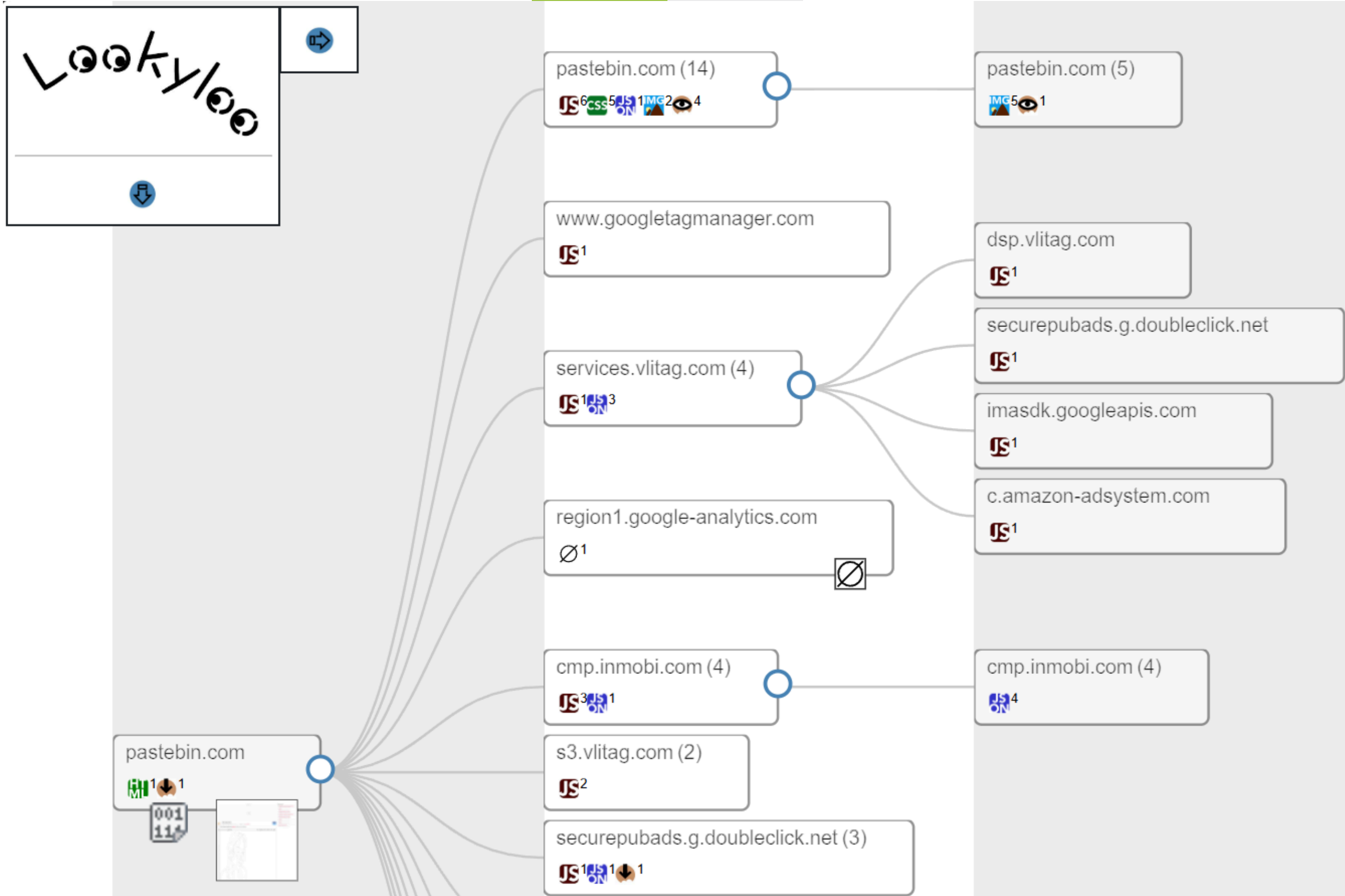

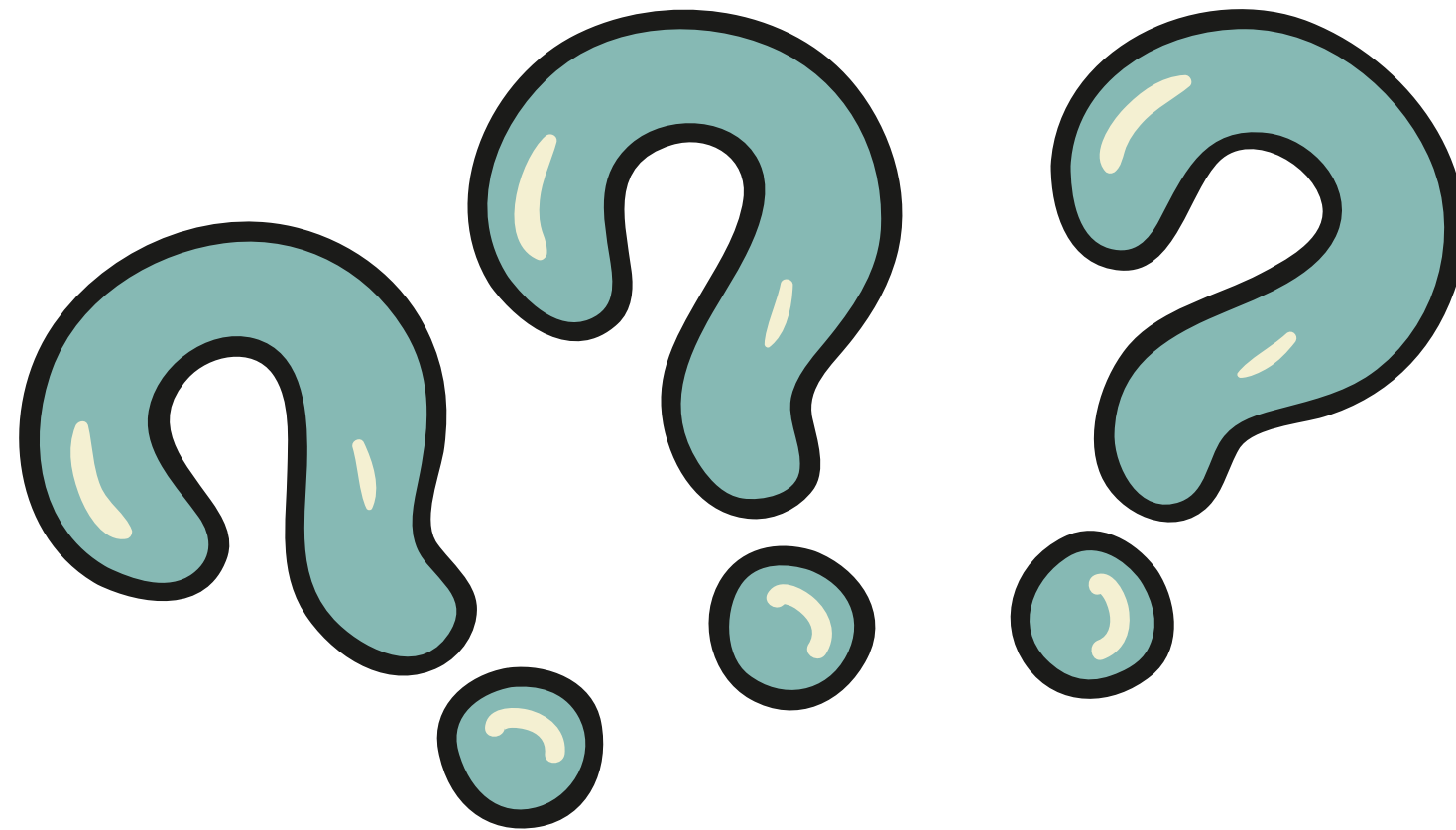
